





Who and what is UlySA?

UlySA is the student alliance of Ulysseus. We are a group of students that make sure that Ulysseus is always keeping the student perspective at heart, offering insights and help on various topics Ulysseus is currently working on.

We were officially founded in November 2024, during the Ulysseus Summit in Nice. We are composed of students from the 8 partnering universities, organised in a steering committee, that handles daily affairs and the operation of UlySA, and a student assembly, that govern our actions.

A student centred perspective

- The core of UlySA activities is to make sure that every action taken by Ulysseus is aligned with the best interest of students. This is made by assisting them in developing new platforms, participating in events and being in the governing bodies of Ulysseus.
- This could be for example, providing informations on what is important for students during their mobility period within the Ulysseus system, or giving opinions and advices during the development of certain programs (eg the Ulysseus AI community in Haaga-Helia).


